Inland Empire (LRC), a nonprofit dedicated to supporting union families and underserved communities through workforce development, disaster preparedness, and economic resilience across Riverside and San Bernardino Counties.

Carmella launched LRC in 2024, guiding its vision from concept to execution. She authored the organization's business plan, completed all incorporation and compliance documentation, and recruited its inaugural Board of Directors. Her leadership led to the successful award of a \$1 million State of California Jobs First Thrive Catalyst Grant, secured in partnership with SoCalCOSH. The funding, coordinated through the Inland Empire Labor Institute and Inland Economic Growth and Opportunity, helped launch both LRC and the Inland Empire Disaster Hub, a critical coordination center advancing regional equity and inclusive workforce infrastructure.

Throughout her career, Carmella has specialized in Executive Board development, membership growth, and strategic outreach. She holds numerous professional certifications, including CERT Train-the-Trainer, Red Cross Mass Care & Sheltering, and the Institute for Organization Management (IOM). She maintains active health and accident insurance licenses in California, Florida and Utah. Her academic background includes a B.S. in Administration of Recreation and Leisure Services from Florida State University and an A.A. from Tallahassee Community College.
